First Grade Units of Study

READING: Practicing a strategy called Metacognition where we focus on thinking about what we are reading – ask your child about making a "Reading Salad" with carrots as the text and lettuce as the thinking!

WRITING: Working on revising our Personal Narratives using Writer's Detail, varied transition words, and more effective endings. We are "fancying-up" one to be officially graded.

MATH: Completing Eureka Math Module 5, which had us looking at: 2-D and 3-D shapes, finding equal parts of both whole shapes and collections, and telling time to the hour and half-hour.

PYP: Beginning our 4th PYP Unit on Where We Are in Place and Time, which focuses on Family. This unit will feature a formal speech where students will give an oral presentation about special Family Traditions. We will also look at family roles and responsibilities.
