First Grade Units of Study

READING: Having fun playing with sounds of letters with games like Sound Dominos and studying different ways to turn a singular word into a plural.

WRITING: Starting to work on the many skills involved in writing Personal Narratives. These include staying on topic, adding lots of interesting detail, using transition words, and ending our stories with a definite conclusion.

MATH: Working through Engage NY/Eureka Math Module 2, which focuses on adding and subtracting with numbers greater than 10. Students are practicing how to "make a 10"/"take from 10" and continue the equation with that friendly number.

PYP: Beginning our third PYP Unit "How We Express Ourselves". We'll study different ways to use our voices, faces, and bodies to express ourselves and then move into mentor texts to help us express ourselves with writing.
